**Note:** In addition to annual dues, schools and school districts in the states of Alabama, California, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Indiana, Illinois, Indiana, Louisiana, Maryland, Missouri, New Hampshire, New Mexico, New York, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Texas, and Wisconsin pay additional state chapter dues of \$50, \$100 or \$150 depending on enrollment (small, medium, large and mega-large institutions, respectively).

Schools and districts in Massachusetts pay an additional \$150 for chapter dues.

Virginia does not collect state chapter dues.
